## DAIWA WINDCAST BR 5000LDA REELS

Daiwa's Infinity BTR free-spool big-pit reel has long been a popular choice among carp anglers looking for big-casting performance but with thet free-spool facility. It's a reel that we see on very many of the banks of venues up and down the land and, oddly, not just big-pit waters either, such is the love for the reel itself as well as what it can do.

This year, with the angler on a more restrictive budget in mind, Daiwa has added a free-spool version to its impressive Windcast range, namely the BR5000LDA and it looks an absolute cracker.

Boasting several of Daiwa's modern-reel features including the super-light Airbail bail arm, Twistbuster, which makes heavy use with thick lines much more bearable, and infinite anti-reverse system, the package belies its relatively modest price tag.

Looks wise, as we've all come to expect from Daiwa, it's up there with reels costing two or three times as much. Three of these adorning your cherished carp wands will very nice indeed and wil have visitors to your swim swooning over your setup.

The reel isn't the lightest, but then at this price you cannot expect it to be made from titanium! On a heavier test curve rod that weight is somewhat balanced out, obviously, so it's not too big a deal. We're looking forward to further tests.
